



Dear New University of Oregon International Student:

Congratulations on your acceptance and decision to attend the University of Oregon. We at the University Health Center look forward to serving your health care needs. To help us do so, please complete or address the enclosed information that includes:

- 1. **MEASLES & MUMPS COMPLIANCE: You cannot register or attend classes until we have the required records.** The University of Oregon requires that all students provide documentation of two doses of measles/mumps vaccine or other acceptable proof of immunity or exemption. Before you are able to register for University of Oregon classes, you must submit an Immunization/ Exemption Certificate for International Students – Measles and Mumps from a doctor that you have had the disease(s); Measles and Mumps (see attached or go to http://healthcenter.uoregon.edu/immunization/required_international.html).

OR

- 2. If you do not have proof of immunizations or having had the disease(s), you can receive the vaccines or blood tests for a fee at the University of Oregon Health Center upon arrival. However, waiting to get vaccines or blood tests at the University of Oregon will delay your registration for classes.

It is recommended that you get vaccines and/or blood tests in your country prior to coming to the University of Oregon.

In order for you to register for classes on time, the University of Oregon measles/mumps coordinator must receive the Exemption Certificate for International Students – Measles and Mumps by the following dates:

September 19, 2008	December 26, 2008	March 20, 2009	June 12, 2009

Please put your full name and University of Oregon student identification number (UO ID found on your Admissions letter) on all records.

- 3. **HEALTH HISTORY: Please complete the enclosed (or see http://healthcenter.uoregon.edu/forms/Personal_Health_History.pdf) personal health history form and return it with your immunization documentation as soon as possible.** If you have serious or chronic health problems, please have your home doctor send us copies of your records. If you have ongoing healthcare needs, please schedule a visit with one of our health care providers soon after your arrival so that we can familiarize ourselves with your needs and develop a care plan.
- 4. **HEALTH INSURANCE:** University of Oregon international students and their accompanying dependents are required to have health and accident insurance. **Please see the enclosed (or see enclosed information sheet) information sheet.**
