How do I enter the Health Center?

The main entrance to the Health Center is located on the north side of the building facing the Oregon hall. The north entrance is fully accessible for all students. You can reach all Health Center departments as well as the Counseling & Testing Center through this entrance. We hope to have our south entrance facing the Walton Complex open for use by late September. This will allow easy access to all Health Center services as well as the Counseling & Testing Center through both entrances.

Has construction affected the services available at the Health Center?

Our mission is to provide high quality medical care to students, and we are here to serve your health care needs. While construction is rapidly approaching completion, usable space for our medical and dental practitioners is currently limited. During the first weeks of the fall 2006 term we will use our available clinic space and staff to meet the needs of students who require immediate medical evaluation or treatment due to illness or injury.

Please be sure to let us know if you need a refill on a medication. Our Pharmacy is open for medication refills.

We will schedule future appointments for students who do not have pressing health care needs and resume routine and health maintenance services as soon as additional space becomes available. Do not hesitate to tell us if you feel you need to be seen more quickly rather than being scheduled for a future appointment.

We hope to have all of our medical clinic space open for students by the third week of classes. Our Dental Clinic services may not be available until late October. Our Dental Clinic staff can refer you to a dentist in the community if you are experiencing a problem.

We continue to offer on-site laboratory, x-ray, and pharmacy services. Sports Medicine and physical therapy services are available at our Sports Medicine Clinic in the Rec Center. We hope to have preventive dental services available in mid to late October.

What's going on at the Health Center?

The University Health and Counseling Center is adding a 10,000 square foot addition and remodeling much of the interior of the existing building to better serve your health needs. Construction started in September 2005 and is expected to be completed by late October 2006. When completed the Health Center will offer a number of improvements:

1. Welcoming, open, light, and accessible spaces for direct services to students

2. All medical care clinics located on the first floor
3. Health promotion services highly visible and accessible location
4. Student clinical services located on the first floor
5. Greatly improved way finding to enable students to move easily through the building
