1. **Updates:**

- 1) **ACHA (American College Health) Meeting** – Tom Ryan reminded students of the opportunity for one of them to attend the ACHA meeting that is scheduled May 30 through June 3. If anyone is interested in attending please contact Kim Barker or Tom Ryan. Dr. Ryan will be doing a presentation on “How to Have an Effective SHAC,” talking about structure of the various models of SHACs, recruitment, responsibilities, and activities—how do you set up a SHAC, how do you keep people interested, and what SHACs do. He could incorporate into this presentation a student talking about our SHAC at the UO. Students do not have to help with this presentation, but it would be welcomed. Expenses would be paid for the student by the Health Center.

Tom Ryan and Kim Barker will be doing this presentation at the PCCHA (Pacific Coast College Health Association) meeting this fall. This meeting is in Vancouver, BC. We can also take a SHAC student to this meeting.

- 2) **In-service** - Folake Soetan got an email from the Kyna Langhorne, Director of the Nontraditional Students Union, who felt it would be great to do an in-service, but thought we should let our focus be on the health issues of the older population, such as the four stages of menopause (for females) as well as stress management and overall body health.

We will put this topic on the SHAC agenda so we can brainstorm to come up with some key topics. Folake was asked to invite Kyna or her representative to come to the SHAC meeting next week to help us with this. Kyna should also be asked to bring as many nontraditional students who are interested to our SHAC meeting to discuss their issues and ways the Health Center can better serve them, and who might be willing to serve on a panel for the Health Center in-service.

- 3) **Student Insurance Plan** - Debbie Alley, Student Insurance Plan Coordinator, is meeting with Brian Corcoran, our insurance plan consultant, to look at the student plan for next year and also about basic

automatic insurance plans or some sort of insurance that would cover a reasonable percentage for outpatient costs, such as we have discussed here in the SHAC.

- 4) **Patient Information Survey** – Kim Barker was asked to format the survey and bring it to our SHAC meeting next Friday.
