2. **Announcements :**

Measles Update – There have are now 2 cases of measles diagnosed in non-students. There is an outbreak in Japan so if you are traveling be sure you are up-to-date on your measles vaccine. You would have full immunity with 2 immunizations but you should have at least had one dose of the vaccine if you have not had the measles or a blood test that shows you are immune and of born after 1957. A student was seen in the clinic today that may have measles but we are still waiting for the confirmatory test.

Health Promotion – Paula Staight has compiled the data regarding smoke free campus survey for faculty/staff/OAs and shared the data today. This survey was done as a randomized sample and sent out in campus mail hard copies. 177 completed surveys were received back, which is a 35% response rate. If we ever get to the point of making the UO a smoke free campus there will have to be a lot of work done in preparation with support of the students.

1. **ACHA Debrief** – Noelle Ronco stated that she had an amazing experience at ACHA. She enjoyed all of the sessions, especially the Diabetes presentation with Mary Jean Jacobson, RN and Dr. Vickie SkellCerf from our Health Center. She really took the most home from a presentation by the Denver Metropolitan University, “Academic Vital Signs.” When a student with a problem coming into the Health Center they are asked how they are doing in school then given referrals about the different resources in campus in a way that focuses not only on the physical and mental but also on academic wellbeing. There was also a presentation done by My Space. Campuses want students not to put anything associated with their schools (or campus activities) on sites such as this. Some campuses are working towards policies asking students to leave because of the things found on personal web sites and have even giving classes on how to take stuff off the personal sites so it does not have a negative effect on their lives after college; haunt them in their careers. All of the sessions really good, but Noelle also made a lot of really great friends there. What came to her out attending this conference was a proposal for things that could be changed and integrated into our SHAC. Mainly, our SHAC rocks!
